

Terms & Conditions

These Terms and Conditions prevail in the event of any conflict or inconsistency with any other communications, including advertising or promotional materials. Entry instructions form part of these Terms and Conditions. By entering, all entrants will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by them.

The Promoter & Administrator

Eligibility

1. The Promotion is open to residents of the United Kingdom (England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland) aged 18 or over.
2. Entry is restricted to registered RFU grassroots rugby union clubs located within Northampton Saints' designated community region (Northamptonshire, Bedfordshire, Buckinghamshire, Cambridgeshire, Suffolk and North Essex).
3. Employees of the Promoter, Northampton Saints, the Administrator, their immediate families, agents or anyone professionally connected with the promotion are not eligible to enter.
4. Failure to meet the eligibility requirements will result in disqualification.

How to Enter

5. Each eligible club may submit **one entry only**.
6. To enter, clubs must complete the full entry form by clicking [HERE](#).
7. Incomplete, illegible or late entries will not be accepted.
8. No purchase is necessary to enter.

Promotional Period

9. The promotional period opens at 00:01 on Wednesday 8 April 2026 and closes at 23:59 on Friday 1 May 2026 (the “Promotional Period”).

10. Entries received outside the Promotional Period will not be considered.

The Prizes

11. Two winning clubs will each receive:

- A total of £5,000 worth of building materials supplied by Travis Perkins (materials only; labour costs are excluded);

And

- One training session with three Northampton Saints’ first-team players and the Club’s Community Coaching Team, held at Franklin’s Gardens High Performance Centre on Wednesday 27 May between 6pm and 7pm. This will be arranged, and committed to, by Northampton Saints who reserve the right to change the time and date of the training session.

(the “Prizes”).

12. The training session is open to **one boys’ or girls’ team per winning club**.

13. The two winning clubs will attend the same training session unless it is not reasonably practicable to do so, in which case an alternative training session may be arranged.

14. The Prizes are non-transferable, non-exchangeable and no cash alternative prize is available.

Winner Selection

15. Two winners will be selected by a judging panel, with one independent judge, from all valid entries received.

16. Entries will be judged on:

- The positive impact the Prizes are expected to have on each winning club and its members and local community;
- The demonstrated need for renovation, having regard to the current condition of each club’s facilities.

(the “Judging Criteria”).

17. The judges' decision is final and binding. No correspondence will be entered into.

Winner Notification and Claiming the Prize

18. The two winners will be notified within **five (5) days** of the closing date, by Wednesday 6 May 2026, using the phone number or email address included on the Entry Form.

19. The two winners must confirm acceptance of the prize and provide any requested information within 72 hours of the date of notification to claim the prize. During the claim process, the two winners may be asked to confirm their name, email address and proof of identification.

20. If a winner fails to respond within this time, the Prizes will be forfeited. The Promoter reserves the right to award the prize to another valid Entry selected using the Judging Criteria.

21. It is the responsibility of the two winners to provide their correct, up-to-date details at the time of acceptance in order to claim their prize. The Promoter nor the Administrator can be held responsible for the winner failing to supply accurate information.

Publicity

22. The two winning clubs agree that their club name, names of the associated individuals of the club, and the entry may be used by the Promoter and Northampton Saints for publicity purposes in connection with this promotion, including on the Promoter's and Northampton Saints' websites and social media channels.

23. No further compensation will be provided for such publicity.

Intellectual Property

24. Entrants confirm that their entry is original, does not contain any copyrighted material and that they have the authority to submit it.

Data Protection

26. The two winners' details may be shared with third parties strictly where necessary to fulfil the Prizes.

General

27. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, damaged or not received due to technical issues beyond its reasonable control.

28. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry where it has reasonable grounds to believe there has been a breach of these Terms and Conditions or an attempt to gain unfair advantage.

29. If circumstances beyond the Promoter's reasonable control make it necessary to cancel or amend the Promotion, the Promoter will do so in a fair and proportionate manner.

30. Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud or any other liability that cannot be excluded by law.

31. The winning clubs agree that their details may be shared with a third party for the purposes of administering the competition.

32. The Promotion and these Terms and Conditions are governed by English law and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

33. If for any reason any aspect of this promotion is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of infection by computer virus, network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any cause beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify these terms and conditions or suspend the promotion, or invalidate any affected entries.
